Board Workshop – Proposed Desired Future Conditions

The Board of Directors of the Gonzales County Underground Water Conservation District (the District) held a workshop to discuss the proposed desired future conditions for Groundwater Management Area 13 (GMA 13). Present for the meeting were directors: Bruce Ticken, Steve Ehrig, Barry Miller, Bruce Patteson and Kermit Thiele. Also present for the meeting was GCUWCD Manager, Greg Sengelmann. Mr. Bruce Ticken, Board President and Presiding Officer, called the Workshop for the Groundwater Management Area 13 Proposed Desired Future Conditions to order. He made opening remarks on the purpose of the workshop. Information on the development of the proposed desired future conditions was presented by Mr. Greg Sengelmann, General Manager. Mr. Barry Miller made a recommendation that the Board direct Mr. Sengelmann to propose desired future conditions to GMA-13 that are based on 75% of the saturated thickness in the outcrop at the end of the 50 year planning period. The remaining Board of Directors all agreed with the recommendation.


Public Comment:
