

**Gonzales County Underground Water Conservation District

November 2017**

On November 1st I conducted a water well inventory of the Century Oaks Estates and Noah's Land subdivisions.

On November 2nd I attended the Region L Water Planning Group meeting in San Antonio. A copy of the meeting agenda is attached.

On November 15th I attended a meeting with Senator Perry and staff in Austin to discuss the Agriculture, Water, and Rural Affairs Committee interim charges.

On November 20th I met with representatives of the Guadalupe County GCD and area water well drillers to visit the three proposed site locations for the District's Monitor Well Project.

On November 28th I attended a meeting with Representative Larson's staff in Austin to discuss the Natural Resources Committee interim charges.

On November 29th and 30th I attended the Texas Alliance of Groundwater District's Executive and Finance Committee meeting in Salado. A copy of the meeting agenda is attached.

SSLGC's November production was about 942 ac-ft which is about 58 % of the monthly allowable production.

CRWA's November production was about 295 ac-ft which is about 48% of the monthly allowable production.

SAWS November production was about 946 ac-ft which is about 97% of the monthly allowable production.

AQUA's October production was about 28 ac-ft which is about 7% of the monthly allowable production.

The Palmer Drought Index, as of November 28, 2017 indicates that the District is currently under moderate drought conditions.

On November 17th I went to the Alsay/CRWA on County Road 102 and monitored the plugging of two (2) wells being plugged by Alsay, Inc.

On November 24th, I drove Farm to Market 2922, 77, and part of Farm to Market 108, County Roads 173, 186, 180, 123, 179, and 178 looking for non-registered wells.

On November 28th, I drove part of County Road 119, 140, 138, 139 and part of Farm to Market 466 looking for non-registered wells.

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
