

**Gonzales County Underground Water Conservation District
Manager's Report
March 2018**

On March 9th I attended the Texas Alliance of Groundwater District – Texas Desal Group meeting in Bastrop to discuss Chairman Larson's HB 2377 on permitting procedures for brackish groundwater production permits. A copy of the meeting agenda is attached.

On March 14th I met with representatives of Andrews & Foster to collect water samples from the monitor well installed on the Flying J property in Guadalupe County. Andrews & Foster collected a sample from the well and I collected a duplicate sample for quality control analysis. Both samples were submitted to the GBRA laboratory for total coliform analysis as requested by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR). The sample analysis results were received back from the laboratory on March 16th. The total coliform/e. coli analysis was "Absent". The results were forwarded to the TDLR for review. On March 19th the TDLR accepted the monitor well as constructed.

On March 21st I travelled to the Waelder and Luling area to check on the status of three water wells drilled by Leon Davis Water Well & Service Company. I discussed the condition of the wells with the landowners and collected field water quality measurements.

On March 22nd I travelled to the Leesville, Nixon, and Smiley area to check on the status of three water wells drilled by Leon Davis Water Well & Service Company. I discussed the condition of the wells with the landowners and collected field water quality measurements.

On March 27th I travelled to the Nixon area to check on the status of a water well drilled by Leon Davis Water Well & Service Company. I discussed the condition of the wells with the landowner and collected field water quality measurements.

On March 29th I travelled to the Nixon area to check on the status of two water wells drilled by Leon Davis Water Well & Service Company. I discussed the condition of the wells with the landowners and collected field water quality measurements.

On March 26th Barry Miller and I met with Norman Burns to discuss the Warranty Deed from Gonzales County for the office located at 522 Saint Mathew Street. Mr. Burns indicated that the Warranty Deed was the proper legal document for this type of transaction.

On March 29th I attended a meeting with the Monitor Well Project stakeholders to discuss the current status of the Monitor Well Project and the process and schedule for installation of additional monitor wells. A copy of the meeting attendee list is attached.
